Purpose:

- Assess construction progress in relation to the set timeline.
- Validate accuracy of original draw requests and review budget.

Best Practice:

- A construction lending practice to validate progress while disbursing funds.
- Ensures loan proceeds align with the collateral and identifies early progress concerns.

Why are Draw Inspections Important?

- Accountability: Ensures all construction loan funds are accounted for.
- Risk Mitigation: Determines project progress to mitigate financial risks.
- Funds Tracking: Inspector accounts for every cost request against onsite representation.
- Builder Assurance: Ensures timely payment for completed work and funding for the next construction phase.
- Project Owner Benefit: Supports smooth and timely project completion.
